Comparing Decimals Practice

In this worksheet, we will practice comparing decimals. We will use the symbols > "is more than", < "is less than" and = "is equal to" to compare the decimals.

See the examples below:

$$1.677 < 1.77, \text{ since } .677 = 677/1000 \text{ and } .77 = 770/1000$$

$$2.250 = 2.25$$

$$2.30 > 2.228, \text{ since } .30 = 300/1000 \text{ and } .228 = 228/1000$$
