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## Rounding Whole Numbers

In this worksheet, we will practice rounding whole numbers to the nearest thousand, ten thousand, and hundred thousand. First, let us review place value.

In the number 1,234,567:
1: millions' place
2: hundred thousands' place
3: ten thousands' place
4: thousands' place
5: hundreds' place
6: tens' place
7: ones' place

The general rule for rounding is that if the next number is 5 or above to round up one; but if it is less than 5 , the number stays the same. Then, all the numbers after that change to zeroes.

For example: 234, 862 rounded to the nearest thousand is 235, 000
