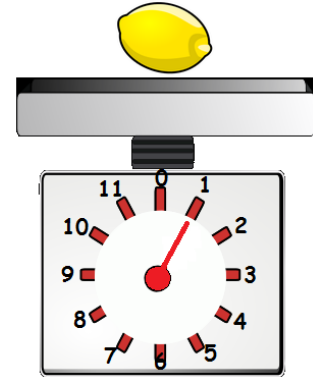

In this worksheet, we will practice describing objects by their weights.

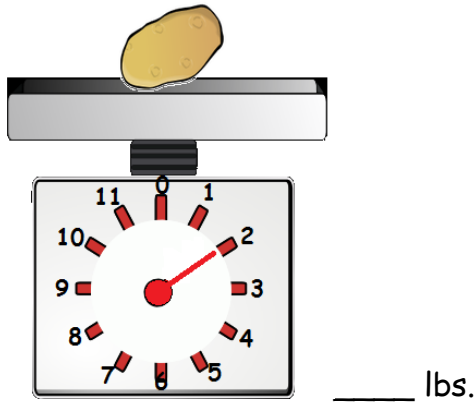
For example, the scale on the right points to 1.

So, the lemon weighs 1 lb.

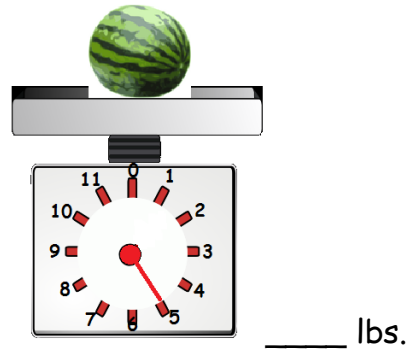
