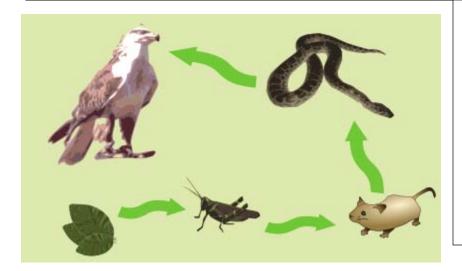

Tertiary: eats the secondary consumer

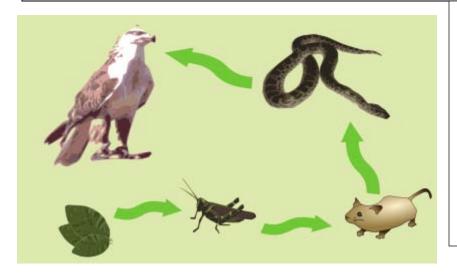
